



GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Please note the following information for the preparation of your poster presentation:

- 1) The poster must be prepared in A1 size (594 x 841 mm) with portrait orientation.
- 2) The poster's contents (text, illustrations, etc.) should be legible from a distance of at least one meter.
- 3) The poster should be written in English and typically have the following contents:
 - Title - to be placed at the top center of the poster
 - Names of all authors with affiliations - corresponding author to be indicated, contact to be provided
 - Introduction - motivation, objectives, context
 - Materials and Methods - theoretical models, experimental setup, and procedures
 - Results and Discussions - highlight the significance of the findings supported by graphs, tables, etc.
 - Conclusions
 - Acknowledgments and
 - References
- 4) Posters must be set up on 21st September 2022 (Wednesday), at least 15 minutes before the conference begins (8.30 am).
- 5) Posters can be dismantled on 23rd September 2022 (Friday) from 10.00 am to 12.00 pm.
- 6) Please mount your poster according to the code number ISCIC2022/ FISAS2022/ ICFIC2022 (left side) and CPXX/ FFP-XX (Fisheries)/ FAP-XX (Animal)/ IPXX (right side) assigned to you during the registration.
- 7) The organising committee will provide Velcro tape to the presenters for poster mounting.
