- **Cultural Heritage, Traditional Knowledge and Community Empowerment** : Recognises the cultural significance and ancestral knowledge associated with indigenous crops, empowering local communities through the preservation and transmission of traditional agricultural practices.
- **Sustainable and Innovative Indigenous Crop Management for Food Security** : Focuses on advancing sustainable cultivation methods, integrating modern technologies, and adopting climate-smart practices to enhance productivity, resilience, and long-term food system sustainability.
