Conference Overview

The 18th Conference and Exhibition of the International Society for Nutraceuticals and Functional Foods (ISNFF) will be held for the first time at the Imperial Hotel Bintulu, Sarawak, Malaysia, from 2nd to 6th August 2026, in conjunction with the 3rd Congress on Sustainable Agriculture and Food Security (COSAFS). This is the first time that ISNFF2026 is being held in Sarawak, gathering scientists, industry leaders, and policymakers to exchange knowledge and explore innovations in nutraceuticals, dietary supplements, and functional foods, with the aim of improving health and managing disease risk.

Over the years, the ISNFF has successfully bridged the gap between the scientific community, healthcare professionals, industry stakeholders and the public through its conferences, short courses, newsletters and other publications. Since its establishment in 2008, ISNFF has served as a global platform to promote natural health products, aiming to improve health and manage disease risk. Previous ISNFF conferences have attracted between 400 to 2,000 participants from around the world. The Journal of Functional Foods was its first official journal created by its Founding Editor. Journal of Food Bioactives is now serving as its main publication of the society. ISNFF, as a Disciplinary Interest Group of the IUFoST, regularly organises short courses and seminars. Join us in Sarawak for an exceptional opportunity to network, collaborate, and shape the future of food, nutrition, health, and sustainability.

Themes (Topics)

- **Nutraceuticals and Functional Ingredients** : Focuses on the discovery and application of bioactive compounds such as polyphenols, carotenoids, proteins, peptides, amino acids, and functional lipids, including omega-3 and palm-based products, to promote health and prevent disease. Regulatory frameworks while promoting research, wellness policies, and innovation in functional foods and dietary supplements.
- **Functional Foods and Their Health Benefits** : Explores the health-promoting properties of fruits, vegetables, grains, legumes, nuts, tea, coffee, and cocoa, alongside innovations in fermented, marine, and botanical-based foods to enhance nutritional and therapeutic value.
- **Advances in Nutraceuticals and Functional Foods** : Highlights the emerging science of functional carbohydrates, microbiome research, and the role of prebiotics, probiotics, synbiotics, and postbiotics in human health, integrating nutrigenomics, personalised nutrition, and AI-driven innovations.
- **Integrative Approaches to Nutraceuticals and Functional Foods** : Emphasises advanced techniques to improve bioavailability and controlled delivery of bioactives, incorporating green technologies, upcycling, zero-waste processing, smart packaging, and halal-certified ingredient development.
- **Palm Oil, Palm Products, and Palm Bioactives** : Addresses palm oil composition, usages and stability. Palm oil carotenoids, tocotrienol and other bioactives. Palm products as traditional and novel formulation designs, and other topics.
